DAY TWO

Morning

- Stroll down historic Main Street. Do some shopping at one of one of the many antique shops and gift boutiques.
- Enjoy some homemade country cooking at Fava's or grab a burger and fries at Galvin's.

Afternoon

- Visit the Old Friends Farm for Retired Thoroughbreds, a non-profit thoroughbred retirement farm that is home to over 100 former racehorses whose racing and breeding careers have ended.
